A distinctive feature of Nanotec2009.it will be the **Networking Day**, at which will be devoted the entire April the 3rd 2009. The day is organised with the **Italian Institute for Foreign Trade (ICE)** and with the support of **APRE (Agency for the Promotion of European Research)**.

The day will be arranged around a number of presentations and one-to-one meetings aimed to promote research and industrial collaborations, which will see the presence also of representatives from Industry, Research Institutions, and Venture Capitalists coming from **China, Japan, USA and Italy**.
